2019 First Destination Survey Highlights

The data for this report were collected by online survey, follow-up telephone calls, faculty, and social media. The Office of Career Services surveyed undergraduate students who received first-time bachelor degrees between July 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019. The report is based on a knowledge rate of 74% (or 250 graduates of the 336 receiving traditional undergraduate degrees).

Of the 250 respondents:

- 235 (94%) Career outcome rate (% of graduates who fall into employed FT/PT related, employed FT/PT unrelated, volunteer service, military, or continued education.
- 162 (65%) reported "Employed" (FT/PT related)
- 22 (15%) reported "Employed" (FT/PT unrelated)
- 47 (19%) reported "Continuing Education"
- 105 (52%) reported working in North Dakota
