First Destination Survey Highlights

The data for this report were collected by online survey, follow-up telephone calls, faculty, and social media. The Office of Career Services surveyed undergraduate students who received first-time bachelor degrees between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. The report is based on a knowledge rate of 77% (or 381 graduates of the 493 receiving traditional undergraduate degrees).

Of the 381 respondents:

- 353** (93%) Career outcome rate (% of graduates who fall into employed FT/PT related, employed FT/PT unrelated, volunteer service, military, or continued education.
- 228** (65%) reported "Employed" (FT/PT related)
- 25** (7%) reported "Employed" (FT/PT unrelated)
- 86** (24%) reported "Continuing Education"
- 175** (66%) reported working in North Dakota
